→ **ACCORD - Annual Collection 15th & 16th February will replace the share collection during Mass.** *ACCORD is the marriage care service of the Catholic Church, and has been focusing on relationships for more than 50 years. For all that time, and still today, the services are available to all who need them, whether or not they are able to pay. ACCORDS work consists of three separate strands, which together support people and their relationships at key moments in life. 1: Schools Programme, 2: Marriage Preparation, and 3: Counselling.*

→ **St Anthony Devotions take place every Tuesday after 10am Mass** (a funeral Mass takes precedence). A new leaflet will be available soon to assist with the St Anthony Prayers, the relic of St Anthony is available to venerate after the devotional prayers.
