## Special Measures - Coronavirus

- You are not required to physically attend Sunday Mass, in the emergency.
- Collection baskets will not be passed around. 4 baskets will be placed in four locations in the Church. You can place donations in those baskets.
- Please do not shake hands at the sign of peace, we advise you to bow instead. You should not receive communion on your tongue.
- Ministers of the Eucharist must wash their hands before and after distributing communion, located in the Sacristy.
- All services will be limited to a maximum of 100 people. This includes Masses, Funerals, Baptisms and Weddings.
- Please space yourselves out to 1 meter approx. However, family groups who live together in any case, can sit together.
- Confirmations are postponed until further notice.
- If you have symptoms of flu or coronavirus, phone your GP or local emergency department (ED) without delay and remain in the house. Do not go to your GP or ED. Phone them first. If you do not have a GP, phone 112 or 999.
