→ If any parishioners still have their Trócaire box or donations at home, please bring them to the Parish Office.

→ Last week a new automated door was installed on the side entrance of the Church (disabled access entrance). This automated door will assist those with a disability, it is especially designed for wheelchair access. The wooden door on the inside is still in place, if weather conditions allow please leave this open. If the door is closed and you see a parishioner requiring assistance, please do help and open the door for them.

→ The Parish Office and Our Lady's Hall were closed due to the safety measures during the Coronavirus. They will reopen on the 9th July 9:30am.

→ As you are aware the Church depends on your donations to keep going. Easter dues can still be paid if you are in a position to do so. You can also go online to pay any donations, including first and second collections www.fairviewparish.ie.

→ We have also added two card machines (porch at front door and Our Lady's Altar) These can be used to make payments by debit card for example.
