→ We remember **Fr. Tony Coote** on the 1st Anniversary of his passing.

(28th August 2019). Tony was born in Dublin on Bloomsday, June 16th 1964. Tony Coote was the eldest of five boys, one of whom Alan, died in infancy. His family lived in Dublin's Fairview and Santry. After school at St Joseph's C.B.S. in Fairview, Tony worked at sundry jobs until at the age of 21, he decided on the priesthood and entered the seminary at Clonliffe in September 1985. Tony was ordained in 1991, he was appointed chaplain to Ballymun Comprehensive secondary school and the Sisters of Charity in Drumcondra. In 2000 he was appointed chaplain at UCD and then as administrator of Mount Merrion parish in 2008 and of Kilmacud parish also in 2009. He was diagnosed with motor neurone disease, on 28/02/2018 and passed away on 28th August 2019. Fr Tony's funeral was held in the Church of St. Thérèse, Mount Merrion.
