Feast of Our Lady of the Angels: title of the Blessed Virgin under which St. Francis placed the Order. St. Francis had great devotion to Our Lady under this title due to his repairing of the little chapel of the "Portiuncula" (little portion) in the woods outside Assisi and becoming devoted to it as a place of prayer and meditation in which the earliest brothers gathered and St. Clare was first received into her vows, where St. Francis had a number of visions on Our Lady and the Angels and received the famous privilege of the "Pardon of Assisi" from the Pope, (*a plenary indulgence that anyone may receive under the usual conditions in any church throughout the world in honour of Our Lady of the Angels*)

Portiuncula Indulgence

→ To obtain the Portiuncula (2 August) **plenary indulgence asked by St. Francis from the pope**, a person must go to Mass, with the intention of honoring Our Lady of the Angels. Then perform the work of reciting the **Creed and Our Father and pray for the Pope's designated intentions**. You should be free, at least intentionally, of attachment to venial and mortal sin, and truly repentant. Make your **sacramental confession** 8 days before or after. Participate and assist at Mass and **receive Holy Communion** 8 days before or after.

Donations / Collections

→ As you are aware the Church depends on your donations to keep going. It is possible to go online to pay any donations, including first and second collections www.fairviewparish.ie.

→ As handling coins and bank notes is being discouraged. The Parish has added two card machines (porch at front door and Our Lady's Altar). These can be used to make payments by debit card for example. If you need to enter pin or amount, the top section of the machine has buttons.
