Parish Newsletter: 9th – 15th August 2020

→ Fr Joe Connick has arrived safely in Canada, he had a safe journey and no problems. He is now in automatic quarantine for anyone traveling outside mainland Canada, with the Friars in Toronto. When we have a final address, we will let you know.

→ **On Saturday 15th August for the feast of ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY, there will be two Masses in the morning 8am and 10am. There will not be a Vigil Mass for the Assumption on Friday evening. There will be the normal Sunday timetable Vigil Mass 5:30pm, 9:30am, 10:45am, 12noon, 1:15pm and 6pm.**

→ If possible, please go to a Mass where there would normally be less parishioners in order to keep the numbers below 50 for each Mass.

→ Hand sanitizers are located in the porch at the main door and on the wall beside the missalette holder at the side entrance. 2-meter distancing is advised, and a label has been placed on the pew to indicate social distancing.

→ Our Lady's Hall Parish Centre is available to hire, Groups are returning to Our Lady's Hall when the STAY SAFE & appropriate time arrives for their Group.

→ We will be modifying the confessional with a plastic screen, between the priest and someone coming to confession

→ On **Friday 14th August is the feast of St. Maximilian Kolbe - Mass will be at 8am and 10am.** John Paul II declared him "The Patron Saint of Our Difficult Century". *Toward the end of his days at Niepokalanow, Fr. Kolbe celebrated more often in the chapel of the sick friars. In his homilies, he touched on the value of sacrifice. "Jesus Christ," he said, "without a doubt, chose for the work of redemption the means most important and rich in merit, namely suffering... Apart from the Cross there is no salvation for the soul nor hope for everlasting life." Blessed the soul that grasps the value of suffering.*
