- **Adoration** takes place 6pm – 7pm in the main Church. Blessed Sacrament Chapel will remain closed. 
- **Vigil of Reparation for Irelands turning from Christ will take place on Saturday 12th September at 1pm - 4:30pm**
Rosary, adoration, Benediction, Confession, Veneration of the relic of the Holy Face of JESUS. This will also be available ONLINE
- **Our Lady's Hall and Parish Center will close** for activities from 18th August until 13th September following the Government restrictions to combat coronavirus. The Parish Office will remain open for now, however the situation may change at any time.
- Dublin Diocesan **Pilgrimage Lourdes at Home**. Next Tuesday (September 8th) Archbishop Diarmuid Martin will begin the first ever **"Virtual Lourdes Pilgrimage"** with an Opening Mass in St. Bernadette's Church, Clogher Road. The pilgrimage will take place in six different Churches in the Diocese over five days and on webcam. As numbers are restricted in each Church, the wider public are invited to join live online. For members of the Deaf community there will be an ISL Interpreter at all venues through the virtual journey.
