- ➔ **Feast of Visitation of Blessed Virgin Mary** will be held on 31st May.
This celebrates the visit of Mary, the Mother of God, with the child Jesus
in her womb, to her cousin Elizabeth. The visit took place when Elizabeth
was herself six months' pregnant with the forerunner of Christ, Saint
John the Baptist. At the Annunciation of the Lord, the angel Gabriel, in
response to Mary's question "How shall this be done, because I know
not man?" (Luke 1:34), had told her that "thy cousin Elizabeth, she also
hath conceived a son in her old age; and this is the sixth month with her
that is called barren: Because no word shall be impossible with God"
(Luke 1:36-27). The evidence of her cousin's own near-miraculous
conception had called forth Mary's fiat: "Behold the handmaid of the
Lord; be it done to me according to thy word." It is thus appropriate that
the very next action of the Blessed Virgin that Saint Luke the Evangelist
records is Mary's "making haste" to visit her cousin.
