Reflection : St Damien, Martyr of Charity. (written by Fr Ultan
Naughton)

With so much talk about Covid-19, it is good to reflect that our world has
been here before. One of the worst cases of the past was leprosy. Damien
arrived to a vision of hell on the island of Molokai. Lepers were dumped off
boats, often far from shore, and left to fend for themselves, often limbless,
often blind with no basic sanitation. Damien built accommodation and
orphanages, churches and public buildings with his bare hands. He formed a
band and got a choir together with people who had destroyed vocal chords
and no limbs. From the beginning he referred to his charges as 'We lepers'.
'My greatest pleasure is to go there (the cemetery) to say my beads, and
meditate on that unending happiness which so many of them are already
enjoying.'

'Without the constant presence of Our Divine Master upon the altar in my
poor chapels, I never could have persevered casting my lot with the lepers of
Molokai'
