# The indulgence of St. Mary of the Portiuncula

On Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> August a plenary indulgence may be acquired in parish churches. The practice prescribed for the obtaining of the indulgence are a devote visit to the Church and the recitation of One 'Our Father', Creed and go to confession (one week before or after) and receive Holy Communion. Then, pray one 'Our Father', one 'Hail Mary' and one 'Glory' for the intentions of Pope Francis. The visit to Church may be made from noon the previous day until midnight of the day itself.

The Basilica of Saint Mary of the Angels was built over the chapel St Francis built, and so the little sanctuary of the Portiuncula has been preserved in its original condition. By virtue of their apostolic power the popes have extended this indulgence to all Franciscan churches. They have also granted that the indulgence can be gained not only once, but as often as anyone, who has been to confession and to holy Communion, visits the appointed church on Portiuncula day. The indulgence can be applied to the holy souls in purgatory on your prayer intention.
