We distribute food and clothes vouchers, and occasionally help with a household bill. During Covid-19 we had to rely on phone calls and posting of vouchers. Hopefully we can resume our visits soon. It is so much nicer to chat face to face with people, particularly elderly people who otherwise may not have any visitors. This past year has been very hard on everyone including St Vincent de Paul as we couldn't raise funds. We will soon have requests for help with back-to-school items such as books and uniforms. This will put extra pressure on families, some of whom may have lost their jobs due to the pandemic. It is good to be able to help them in these situations, every little helps.
