SVP Envelope can be found in the Church, PLEASE DONATE - SCHOOL HELP

The Society of St Vincent de Paul (SVP) took almost 300 calls every day last week
from parents struggling with back-to-school costs. Calls for help with school costs
are up 10% compared to previous years.

SVP says the level of demand underlines the need for much greater investment
in the education system to ensure that all children and young people can access
and participate in education on an equal footing.

The charity says many of the calls received relate to requests for financial help
with parental contributions, schoolbooks, digital equipment, and help with the
cost of school uniforms.

This pressure is coming at a time when many families are struggling with rising
utility costs.

Members of SVP are particularly concerned about the number of calls they are
receiving from worried parents in relation to the cost of iPads and tablets.
