A Tribute to Grandparents

The family is often referred to as the domestic church, in which our
grandparents play a significant role, preserving our roots and passing on the
Christian Faith to the young. Their vocation of handing down long-standing
traditions to their children and grandchildren is a wonderful part of the
familial bond of love. My own memories of my maternal Grandad remain with
me forever, he was a man of prayer and faith, and his love of the Rosary left a
lasting impression on all our family to this day.

Saints Joachim and Anne, the parents of Mary and grandparents of Jesus, have
long been considered as exemplars for married couples and are one of the few
married couple saints canonised in the Catholic Church. They were greatly
blessed by God who gave them a daughter conceived without sin who was to
become the Mother of Our Lord. Good St. Anne is a much-loved saint of the
Church for centuries. Popes, Saints and the laity attribute many favours
received through her intercession. It is recorded that St Teresa of Avila often
said, “we know and are convinced that our good mother St. Anne helps in all
needs, dangers and tribulations”.

Earlier this year Pope Francis established the *World Day for Grandparents and
the Elderly*, to honour their contribution to our lives. It will be held on the
fourth Sunday of July, close to the feast day of Saints Joachim and Anne on 26th
July each year. At the announcement in Rome, the Holy Father affirmed that
“grandparents are the link between the different generations, to pass on to
the young the experience of life.” Pope Francis reminds us that no one is saved
alone, and that we must treasure the spiritual and human wealth that has
been handed down from generation to generation.
