# Parish Newsletter: 13th - 19th February 2022

<u>Last Friday 11<sup>th</sup> February 2022 was the Feast of our Lady of Lourdes / 30th</u> World Day of the Sick.

Lourdes on a cold day in February 1858, Bernadette Soubirous and 2 companions headed off to the Gave River to collect pieces of wood. The 2 companions ran ahead and left Bernadette struggling to keep up. As Bernadette was taking off her shoes to make her way through the river, startled by a peculiar wind & rustling sound. Bernadette looked up towards the grotto and the caves on the riverbank. Near the opening of the grotto, Bernadette glanced and noticed the cave was suddenly filled with golden light. Lifting up her eyes, she saw a lady of great beauty, dressed in a pure white robe with a blue sash, a veil over her head, a rosary clasped in her hands and yellow roses at her feet. Bernadette rubbed her eyes. What a beautiful lady! But where did she come from? And what was she doing here?

The beautiful lady smiled at Bernadette and asked her <u>to say her rosary</u>. Bernadette said her prayers and when she was finished she looked up, the lady had vanished. The Virgin Mary appeared to Bernadette 18 times in 1858. You should read the full story of the apparitions here

During Covid19, the <u>Dublin Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes</u> 2021 was cancelled. Over the years approximately 2,000 pilgrims travel to Lourdes from all over the Dublin Diocese. Of these, 180 are sick pilgrims staying at the Accueil Notre Dame which is 'a place of welcome' close to the Grotto with many of the facilities of a modern hospital. Another 550 of the pilgrims are voluntary helpers, made up of nurses and doctors, male and female helpers, known as handmaids and brancardiers, a team of chaplains and the Dublin Lourdes Choir.

A further 200 young people assist as well in the care of the sick pilgrims and

A further 200 young people assist as well in the care of the sick pilgrims and many of these are from secondary schools and colleges from around the Dublin Diocese. Parish Groups and individuals from every corner of the Diocese comprise the remainder of the Pilgrimage. **The Children's Pilgrimage** is a much smaller group, but a very important one, as it joins with thousands of other child pilgrims from all over the world each Easter Week. About forty children travel from Dublin assisted by the same number of helpers and a team of chaplains, doctors and nurses. **"Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful" (Lk 6:36).**
