### During Lent

Confession / Reconciliation: During Lent, the sacrament of reconciliation – where we ask God for forgiveness is important. **Confession is held after 10am Mass Monday to Saturday after 10am Mass.**

The Stations of the Cross, a tradition often taking place on Fridays during Lent, allow us to pray with of Jesus's final hours. A booklet to help you join in the stations of the Cross can be found in the Church.

**Devotion of the five Saturdays:** Confession, receiving Communion, reciting five decades of the Rosary and meditating for a quarter of an hour on the mysteries of the Rosary on the first Saturday of five consecutive months. The Confession may be made during the eight days preceding or following the first Saturday of each month, provided that Holy Communion be received in the state of grace. Should one forget to form the intention of making reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, it may be formed at the next Confession, occasion to go to confession being taken at the first opportunity.
