Life is treated by some as Disposable. In Dublin, indeed the world, needs to
hear loud and clear the Gospel message about a culture of life, especially after
our Pope Francis, expressed his sorrow and dismay at the horrific murder last
Monday 20th June 2022 of two Jesuit priests, his fellow Brothers. Slain in a church
in the north of the country of Mexico, together with a layman seeking refuge
from drug dealer. 79-year-old Fr. Javier Campos Morales, and 80-year-old Fr.
Joaquín César Mora Salazar, were slain inside the church in Cerocahui, Mexico.
They were apparently killed after a man fleeing an armed individual took refuge
in the church. The armed person caught up with the man, killing him along with
the two priests. The Jesuits pray that their example, **to save and assist people**
will continue to inspire men and women to give of themselves in service to the
most unprotected in society. On 5th June, a parishioner here in Fairview reminded
the Grey Friars here in the Visitation, Fairview Parish of the murder of the three
Friars killed in Peru in 1991. They are now deemed Martyrs of Catholic Church.
