The Portiuncula was an old church dedicated to the Virgin Mother of God which was abandoned. Francis had great devotion to the Queen of the world and when he saw that the church was deserted, he began to live there constantly in order to repair it. He heard that the Angels often visited it, so that it was called Saint Mary of the Angels, and he decided to stay there permanently out of reverence for the angels and love for the Mother of Christ. This was the place where Saint Francis founded his Order by divine inspiration and it was divine providence which led him to repair three churches He embraced the Mother of Our Lord Jesus with indescribable love because, as he said, "**it was she who made the Lord of majesty our brother, and through her <u>we found mercy</u>. After Christ, he put all his trust in her and took her as his patroness for himself and his friars."**

The Portiuncula indulgence is the first plenary indulgence that was ever granted in the Church. <u>Those who gain the Portiuncula indulgence is freed</u> <u>from all temporal punishments and becomes as pure as after holy</u>.

It was only after he had come to the conviction that Jesus Christ himself wished it, that he granted the petition of the saint and confirmed the indulgence.
