The Indulgence of St Mary of the Portiuncula may be gained on 2nd August.
**By visiting Parish Church and reciting the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, in
addition to sacramental confession, Holy Communion and prayer for the
intentions of the Pope. The visit may be made from noon the previous
day until midnight of the day itself. – You can Save a soul from Purgatory.**

The Portiuncula was an old church dedicated to the Virgin Mother of God
which was abandoned. Francis had great devotion to the Queen of the world
and when he saw that the church was deserted, he began to live there
constantly in order to repair it. He heard that the Angels often visited it, so
that it was called Saint Mary of the Angels, and he decided to stay there
permanently out of reverence for the angels and love for the Mother of Christ.
This was the place where Saint Francis founded his Order by divine inspiration
and it was divine providence which led him to repair three churches
He embraced the Mother of Our Lord Jesus with indescribable love because,
as he said, **“it was she who made the Lord of majesty our brother, and
through her we found mercy. After Christ, he put all his trust in her and
took her as his patroness for himself and his friars.”**

The Portiuncula indulgence is the first plenary indulgence that was ever
granted in the Church. **Those who gain the Portiuncula indulgence is freed
from all temporal punishments and becomes as pure as after holy
baptism.** This was also the reason why Pope Honorius was astonished when
St. Francis petitioned for the confirmation of this indulgence, for such an
indulgence, up to that time, had been entirely unknown. It was only after he
had come to the conviction that Jesus Christ himself wished it, that he granted
the petition of the saint and confirmed the indulgence.
