BROTHER KEVIN CROWLEY OFMCap RETIRES FROM THE CAPUCHIN DAY CENTRE Let us pause and reflect on the thoughts of Bro Kevin on his retirement at a time of great uncertainty for Dublin and the country at large during unprecedented cost-of-living and housing crisis. Following Brother Kevin Crowley serving the people of Dublin for 49 years, charitable work at Capuchin Day Centre. 'I'm not a saint; I just love people' "It's my big fear now that I'm leaving," he says, of the potential for the crisis to get even worse. "For working people, even people who are earning medium wage are seeing difficulties now as well, in paying the ESB bill. And especially if they have four or five children."

"No one should have to queue for food in 2022," he says.

In August 2018, Pope Francis visited the Capuchin Day Centre during his visit to Ireland. Brother Kevin told the Pope that from humble beginnings of providing 50 meals a day, it was providing over 800 meals by 2018.

Brother Kevin said, "the primary concern each day was the dignity and respect of each person attending the Centre."
