**Partnership Of Parishes :** In the Archbishop's Advent Pastoral Letter;

'The Time is now', Archbishop Farrell spoke about the need for parishes to  
work much closer together as we face into a very different future as a Diocese. He  
has decided that the three parishes of Fairview, Marino, and Donnycarney should  
become a 'Partnership of Parishes'. Basically the Archbishop is putting the Parish  
Cluster Idea on a firm and permanent footing. It is envisaged that the three parishes  
will work together, sharing what resources and talents they have, and planning more  
closely together. Last Tuesday afternoon the three Parish Priests, Fr Tom, Fr Marius,  
and Fr Michael, met to begin the process. Information about the parishes was shared,  
which included the amount of weekday and weekend Masses, the number of parish  
schools, our ongoing financial positions, and how best we could respond to the  
challenge Archbishop Farrell has laid before us. The Archbishop has asked that all  
parishes look in particular on the amount of Masses that are celebrated. At the  
moment there are 10 Sunday Masses (excluding the 1pm Ukrainian Mass in  
Donnycarney) being celebrated at the weekends between our three parishes. We  
have to report back to the Archdiocese in May. We will meet again in the near future,  
this time with some representatives from each of the parishes. In the meantime we  
ask for your prayers, and also for your counsel. May Our Lady, and St Vincent de Paul
