Memorial of **Our Lady of Lourdes** 11th Feb, marking the first apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary in 1858 to 14 year old Marie Bernade (St. Bernadette) Soubirous. Between 11th Feb & 16th July, 1858, the Blessed Virgin appeared 18 times, and showed herself to St. Bernadette in the hollow of the rock at Lourdes. On 25th March she said to the little shepherdess who was only 14 years of age: **"I am the Immaculate Conception."** Since then Lourdes has become a place of pilgrimage and many cures and conversions have taken place. The message of Lourdes is a call to personal conversion, prayer, and charity.
