**2013 - 2023: His Holiness, Pope Francis** Today is the anniversary of the

inauguration of the Petrine ministry of Pope Francis, Bishop of Rome in 2013.

During the HOMILY OF POPE FRANCIS, Saint Peter's Square Tuesday, 19<sup>th</sup> March 2013, he prayed ;

**I implore the intercession of the Virgin Mary, Saint Joseph, Saints Peter and Paul, and Saint Francis, that the Holy Spirit may accompany my ministry, and I ask all of you to pray for me! Amen**

### The ongoing crackdown on Church

Nicaragua: Bishop Álvarez sentenced to 26 years' imprisonment, along with other 222 detained opponents to President Manuel Ortega, including five priests, a deacon and two seminarians condemned to 10 years imprisonment on charges of conspiring against the government.

*In the Irish Catholic on 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2023.* Tánaiste Micheál Martin has called for the "immediate and unconditional" release of a Nicaraguan bishop who was sentenced to 26 years' imprisonment after refusing to leave the country for exile insisting he wanted to be with his people. Mr Martin said he was "gravely concerned" about Bishop Rolando Álvarez (56) and the wider crackdown on Church.

*Article in Catholic Herald 13<sup>th</sup> February:* Pope Francis said: "The news from Nicaragua has grieved me a great deal, and I cannot but remember with concern Bishop Rolando Álvarez of Matagalpa, whom I love so much. The Pope said he was also praying **"for all those who are suffering in that dear nation"**.

**"We also ask the Lord, through the intercession of the Immaculate Virgin Mary, to open the hearts of political leaders and all citizens to the sincere search for peace, which is born of truth, justice, freedom, and love and is achieved through the patient exercise of dialogue,"** the Holy Father said.

Let us join the Holy Fathers prayer and maybe contact Tánaiste Micheál Martin [www.gov.ie](http://www.gov.ie) to show agreement to his call for the release of Bishop Álvarez.
