**"Only God!"** is one of Grignion's key formulas. For him, everything comes from the Father and everything returns to the Father. Mary is at the heart of this and rightly so: "When someone has once found Mary, and through Mary, Jesus and through Jesus, God the Father, he has found all that is good...all of God's grace and friendship, all truth against lies, all ease and victory against lies, all ease and victory against difficulties of salvation, all sweetness and all joy in the bitterness of life".

The fact of serving Mary does not lessen the importance of the Cross but it presents it in a totally different way. ***"Since Mary is the mother of the living, she gives all her children pieces of the Tree of Life, which is Jesus' cross."***
