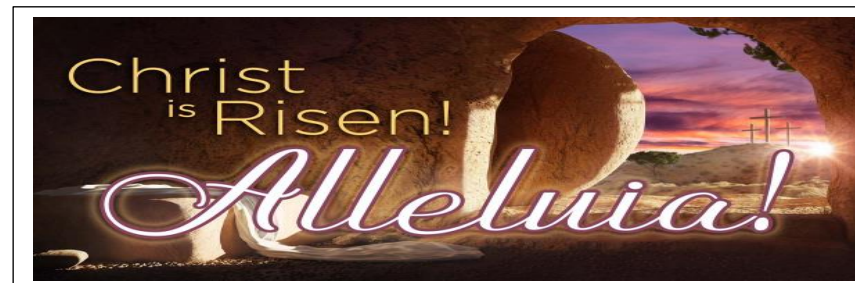

**Divine Mercy Sunday** is celebrated on the second Sunday of Easter and is a religious observance celebrated mostly among Catholics. This year, it takes place on 16<sup>th</sup> April. It is a significant time for reflection on the Christian faith. As Pope John Paul II stated, **"It is a time where we are blessed with divine mercy as it reaches us through the heart of Christ crucified."** Divine Mercy Sunday focuses on the gifts that flowed from Christ's death, burial, and resurrection — his mercy and love that were so freely given to humanity after such a betrayal. Divine Mercy Sunday concludes the Easter celebrations and welcomes the ultimate gift that Christ gave after his crucifixion.

**Living our Christian life is like a** pilgrimage as we follow our personal path to drawing closer to our Lord. There are various paths on this journey to Christ, but each way is a means that God has paved for us to reach our full Christian potential in holiness.
