
Building Hope: The aim of "Building Hope" in the Archdiocese, is for all parishes to act now to give effective witness and service in the years ahead. There is a continued decline in the number of new vocations to the priesthood so we <u>will</u> have fewer priests in the future to support the work in the parishes of the Diocese. The diocese suggested to reschedule and reduce the number Masses. A request was made for Parish Volunteers to come forward to assist the Parish (Cleaning, Music, Parish Office, Altar Servers, Baptismal Team, Ministers of the Word, Collectors, with Our Lady's Hall). However, not many responded to this call to help in the Parish, consequentially the activities of the Church will be reduced. A Parish Council Rep. and Parish Priest will meet with the Partnership of Parishes.

(Visitation Parish, Fairview, St. Vincent de Paul Parish, Marino, Our Lady of Consolation Parish, Donnycarney) to review the Mass Schedule again. Weekday Mass times (8am and 10am) need to change due to the shortage of Priests, also ensuring that different options of Mass times are available for the parishioners who live in Partnership of Parishes.

The more suitable change is to only keep the 8am Mass - Monday to Friday in Fairview, as Marino and Donnycarney celebrate the 10am Mass. Only funeral Masses will be held at 10am in Fairview.
