Parish Newsletter 23rd – 29th July 2023

Daily Mass Monday to Friday – Only 8am Mass from 31st July

Following the suggestion from the Archdiocese of Dublin to reduce the number of Masses. A Parish survey was completed. Fr. Marius and the members of the Fairview Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) counted and reviewed the recent **survey responses** at our PPC meeting on Tuesday 4th July 2023. Parishioners living in the local catchment area, and regular attendees at Fairview Parish Masses who don't reside in the local catchment area were invited to participate in the survey. From the responses received, the 8am Mass has the highest number of total votes.

Based on the survey results below and following lengthy discussion, the Parish team and PPC members agree that the weekday 8am Mass will remain and the weekday 10am Mass will cease, beginning **Monday, 31st July**. The Sacrament of Confession will be available after 8am Mass.

On weekdays where there is a Funeral Mass there will be two Masses, first Mass at 8am followed by the Funeral Mass at 10am. It is the intention of the Parish Team to notify Parishioners, as much as is possible, when funeral Masses are due to take place.

It has been suggested that the Rosary and other prayers, including the Divine Mercy Chaplet, be led daily by lay parishioners from Monday to Friday at 10am in Fairview Church. On one/two days per week, the 10am morning prayers will be followed by a tea & coffee hour in Our Lady's Hall for Parishioners.

The Parish team and PPC members want to strongly emphasise that this is a difficult decision to cease the weekday 10am Mass in Fairview. Fairview PPC members will continue to assess the weekday Mass times at their regular PPC meetings.

Please note that 10am Masses Monday to Friday are available in our partnership parishes, St. Vincent de Paul Church, Marino, and Our Lady of Consolation Church, Donnycarney. The Parish Team would like to sincerely thank everyone who participated in the survey and appreciate the support of all our Parishioners at this time. Thank you and God Bless,
