Gospel Reflection: This Sunday's gospel is a collection of four parables, teaching us about the kingdom of heaven. Be content to choose one and remain with it. To ensure that your meditation remains down to earth, you must clarify what for you is "the kingdom of heaven". It is a biblical expression which means "what happens when God is really king," and it includes his being king of an individual as well as of a community. You might translate it as "growing spiritually" or "getting closer to God." Follow the movement of the teaching: don't start by trying to understand what "the kingdom" means; start with the parable and let it teach you about the kingdom.
