Communion: Communion visits by the Friars to the housebound occurs every month, please contact Fr. Kevin.

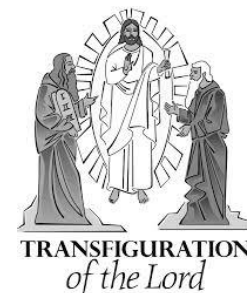
