Gospel Reflection Matthew 22:1-14 : Jesus calls us by our name and invites us to come to the feast. It is up to us whether or not we accept this invitation. We are all invited personally to the table of the Lord. When we gather to celebrate the Eucharist Jesus is the host and we are his guests. We come as we are, not how we would like to be. The Eucharist is offered to us freely and we are invited to respond freely. It is God's gift to us and no one is to be excluded.

November List of Dead Envelopes: The month of November gives us the opportunity to remember our dear departed, when we enter their names on the **Altar List of the Dead**, so that they may be prayed for at all Masses during November and on the first Friday of each month for the coming year.
