This tax relief would be paid directly to Visitation Fairview Parish. As can be appreciated, we can only reclaim tax for Collections when we are able to record the source of these donations. The envelope system facilitates this or write your name and address on envelope. You then simply place your donation in a FAMILY envelope.
