EASTER SUNDAY

Holy Hours and Benediction during Easter Week:



Thursday 4th April : 7pm to 8pm –As part of the Sacred Heart of Jesus devotion, each Thursday before the First Friday, we will have a Holy Hour for Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in order to honour and make reparation to the Sacred Heart. The Holy Hour is on a Thursday evening to recall Our Lord's agony in the Garden of Gethsamni before His passion and death on Good Friday.

Saturday 6th April – In response to the apparitions of Fatima, we will have Marian devotions each First Saturday. There will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament immediately after 10am Mass followed by Benediction. *Then tea / coffee in Our Lady's Hall*.

Jesus asked that the Feast of the Divine Mercy be preceded by a Novena to the Divine Mercy which would begin on Good Friday. He gave St. Faustina an intention to pray for on each day of the Novena.

In her diary, St. Faustina wrote that Jesus told her: "On each day of the novena you will bring to My heart a different group of souls and you will immerse them in this ocean of My mercy.... On each day you will beg My Father, on the strength of My passion, for the graces for these souls."

Divine Mercy Novena, began on Good Friday – immediately after Stations of the Cross and on Holy Saturday at 3pm, the Novena continues on **Easter Sunday – 3pm, Easter Monday – 3pm, Easter Tuesday to Easter Friday – after the 8am and 10am Masses and Easter Saturday – 3pm.**

On Divine Mercy Sunday – 7th April, there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament as part of the Divine Mercy celebrations.


