pay parking fee.

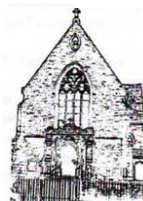
### MINISTRY TO THE SICK

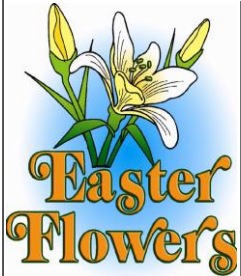
**Prayer to obtain grace through the intercession of Saint Faustina**
