MINISTRY TO THE SICK

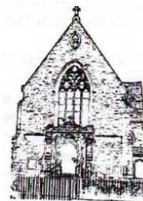
In the case of sudden illness or an emergency

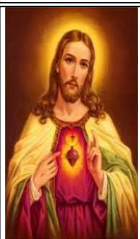
