The **boundary wall of Our Lady's Hall** and Parish Centre was recently assessed by an engineer to help decide on restoration or demolition of the wall. The Parish was advised to repair and then plaster the wall. The estimate cost is €5,500.00. The work has already begun. Donations are great appreciated to complete this work. Please place donation in an envelope, *marked* "Our Lady's Parish Wall Repair".

Parishioners attending Adoration during the winter, informed the Parish Team about the cool **temperature in the Adoration Chapel**. Two types of radiators were tried out, but they did not keep the Adoration Chapel to a suitable temperature. A structural engineer will assess the building – as this is a historic and protected structure. Local builders have recommended repair and insulation of the flat roof, review insulation of front door and retrofitting secondary glazing on the stain glass windows of the Adoration Chapel. The work will continue over the summer months. Adoration enables us to spend time intimately thanking Him for His sacrificial gift expressed in His Eucharistic words: **"This is my body which is given for you"** (*Luke 22:19*). In the Eucharist we encounter Him as the Victim of merciful love, and it is the nature of love that it calls for a return in kind. **"Jesus, I Trust in You."**
