Repair and Insulation of the Adoration Chapel: Parishioners attending Adoration during the winter, informed the Parish Team about the cool temperature in the Adoration Chapel. Built in about 1950 as a Mortuary Chapel. A structural engineer will assess the building. The aim is to repair and insulate the flat roof, review heat loss at the front door and retrofitting secondary glazing on the stain glass windows of the Adoration Chapel. Parish Team will assess the finance of this project and work will begin over the summer months, if the cost is manageable.
