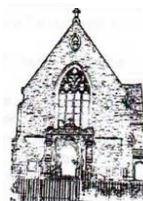
MARRIAGE : **six months** advance notice is required. Details available from the Friars.

Dr. Ben Dhonau (*RIP*) was a **Minister of the Word** at Mass, he offered his time and talent, the scriptures was proclaimed with clarity and with faith at Mass and at other liturgies.
