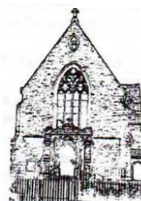

**DCU MA IN THEOLOGY AND WORLD RELIGIONS** Are you interested in

do a degree programme? If so, then Dublin City University, the MA in Theology  
and World Religions is a flexible programme that is suitable for those who are  
busy with jobs and other responsibilities. Lectures are held in the evening, one  
night a week, and the programme can be taken on a part-time or full-time basis.  
SCHOLARSHIPS Available: We have now six half-fees scholarship available for  
part-time applicants. The programme costs €8,000 to be paid over two years.  
With the scholarship, that would be €4,000 over two years (or €2,000 per year).
