the Parish Priest in advance**

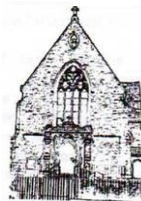

APPOINTMENT OF MGR JOHN KENNEDY AS ARCHBISHOP. The Holy See has announced the appointment by Pope Francis of Monsignor John Kennedy, a Dublin diocesan priest, as titular Archbishop of Ossero. Monsignor Kennedy is Secretary of the Disciplinary Section of the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith. John Kennedy was ordained a priest on 13th July 1993 in the Church of St John the Baptist, Clontarf. Following his ordination, he served as a Curate in the parishes of Crumlin and Francis Street before he was assigned in 1998 to study Canon Law at the Gregorian University in Rome. He began working in the Matrimonial Office of Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith in 2003.
