the Parish Priest in advance**

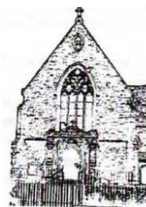

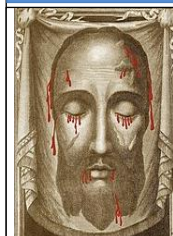
