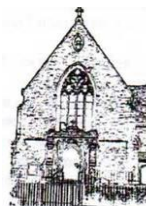
MINISTRY TO THE SICK

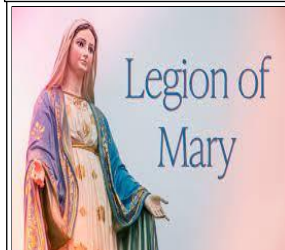

No 10am Mass from Tuesday 17th – 19th September

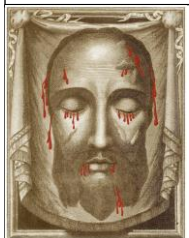
