parking fee.

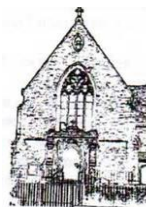
MINISTRY TO THE SICK

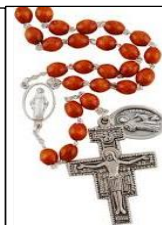
