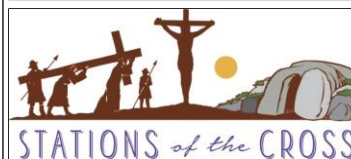

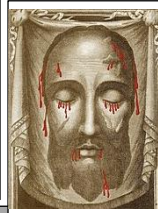

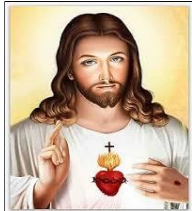
St Francis Charismatic Prayer Group in
