Celebrate the Feast of St. Francis in Italy!

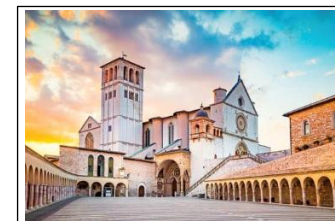
Join us on the 1st – 6th October 2025 for our parish pilgrimage to Rome

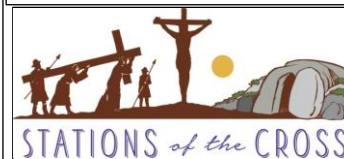
