EASTER SUNDAY

On Good Friday Way of the Cross on 18th April, Cardinal Baldo Reina read
meditations on behalf of Pope Francis and ended with this prayer, let us pray, in the
words of Saint Francis, for the gift of heartfelt conversion:

*"Most High and glorious God, Cast your light into the darkness of my heart. Grant
me right faith, firm hope, perfect charity, and profound humility. Grant me, Lord,
wisdom and understanding, so that I may do your true and holy will. Amen."*

NOVENA TO THE DIVINE MERCY AT FAIRVIEW CHURCH

Begins on Good Friday

Day1: Good Friday. Immediately after the
Stations of the Cross. About 7.40pm.

Day 2: Holy Saturday: 3pm

Day 3: Easter Sunday: After 11.30am Mass.
About 12.30pm.

Day 4: Easter Monday: After 10am Mass. About 10.30am

Day5-8: Easter Tuesday-Easter Friday: After 8am and 10am Masses.

Day 9: Easter Saturday: During the Holy Hour following the 10am Mass.

**Jesus asked that the feast of Divine Mercy be preceded by a Novena to
the Divine Mercy which would begin on Good Friday. He gave St Faustina
an intention to pray for on each day of the Novena.**

In her diary, St Faustina wrote:

*"Jesus told me 'On each day of the novena you will bring to My
Heart a different group of souls and you will immerse them in this
ocean of My mercy*

*....On each day you will beg My Father, on the strength of My
passion, for graces for these souls."*

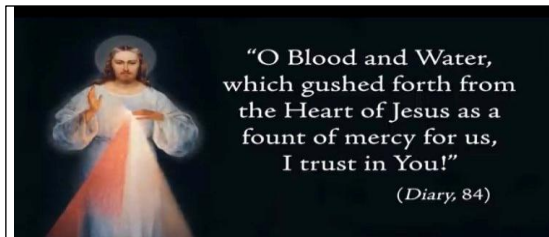
