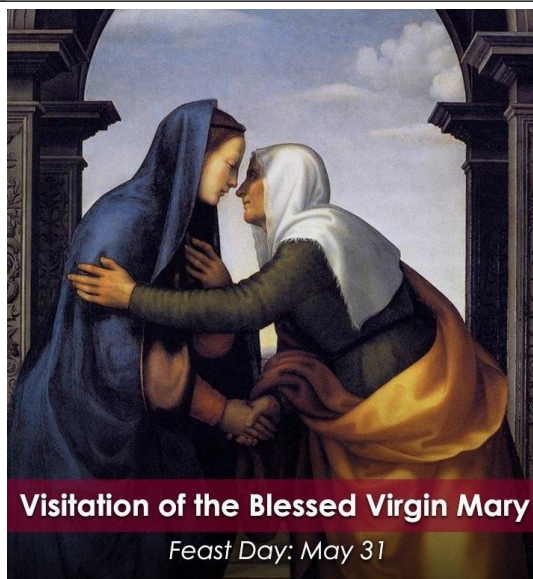

PARISH FEAST DAY

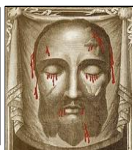
