

VENERATION OF THE RELICS AT ALL THE MASSES ON 3rd and 4th MAY

Two priests of the Conventual Franciscan order, who had been born in communist Poland, were martyred while ministering to the poor in the Andes mountains. The mission of the two priests was not political, but as true followers of Saint Francis of Assisi, they had been sent to minister to the souls and bodies of the poor people of Pariacoto in the Andes mountains. It was hard, tiring work, as the priests lived in poverty among the people, learned their customs, traditions, and language, and encouraged devotion to God and religious vocations.

The lives and deaths of **Blessed Micael and Zbigniew** show us that it is only by walking in the footsteps of Jesus Christ—sharing the poverty of the poor, teaching and living the Beatitudes, and leading one another to God-that we can conquer the darkness of our world. His path of peace and forgiveness is the only one worth following. On August 9, 1991, Shining Path members kidnapped the two priests after celebrating Mass. The Friars were thrown in a pickup truck and taken to another village for a "trial" after which they were killed for their Catholic faith. These two Blesseds continue to intercede for the faithful and a number of miracles have been attributed to their prayers.
