Ordination Mass

Friar Peter George Flynn, who has been serving in the parish as a deacon for the past month, will be ordained a priest through the imposition of hands and the invocation of the Holy Spirit by His Grace, the Auxiliary Bishop of Dublin, Paul Dempsey, in our parish Church here in Fairview on Saturday the 30th of August at 10.30am. The Ordination Mass will be followed by a reception in Our Lady's Hall. All are invited.

Fr. Peter's **First Mass** in Fairview will be the following day, Sunday the 31st of August, at 11.30am. There will be a reception in Our Lady's Hall afterwards. Pope Leo XIV has graciously promised a plenary indulgence (full remission of temporal punishment for sins already forgiven) to all those who attend Fr. Peter's First Mass, on condition that they go to confession in the eight days before or after the Mass, receive Communion on the day and pray for the Pope's intentions, and having complete detachment from all sin, even venial.
