

ECUMENICAL BIBLE WEEK

Ecumenical Bible Week takes place this year from September 7 to 14. The project is supported by the two Archbishops of Dublin and brings together people of different traditions around the Word of God. Because this year is the anniversary of the Nicene Creed, we to explore the text of the Creed, looking in particular at the biblical background to what was agreed in Nicaea all those years ago. Our opening service (on the 7th @ 7pm) is in St Finian's Lutheran Church, Adelaide Road, and the closing service is in Christchurch Cathedral (on the 14th at 3.30pm). "Thinking Allowed" – our discussion forum – takes place on Wednesday, September 10, at 7.30pm in Donnybrook Pastoral Centre. Our Saturday Seminar (three speakers) takes place in St Brigid's Church of Ireland, Stillorgan, at Saturday the 13th, starting at 10.30 and ending at 14.00. All events are free and you warmly encouraged to consider coming yourself to any or all of these events.
