Challenged by the Jews for a sign to justify his actions, he cryptically mentions rebuilding the temple in three days, a reference to his resurrection understood later by his disciples.



## Ardscoil Rís Mission to Zambia :

**Church Gate Collection on 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> November**



From 20th March to 7th April 11 students from Ardscoil Rís Griffith Ave., will travel to Zambia for an immersion experience in a developing country. Much of their time will be in Mongu, western Zambia working with a number of different religious orders: Presentation Sisters, Christian Brothers, Holy Spirit Sisters and the Comboni's.

They will work directly with the projects the orders are involved in like basic education, helping with disabled children, visiting the homes the children come from and working on an education farm set up by the Irish government and run by the Christian brothers. Any contribution that the congregation are able to give to allay the cost of the trip and to be able to donate some money to the projects would be greatly appreciated. Students going on the trip will be collecting outside the church after Mass.
