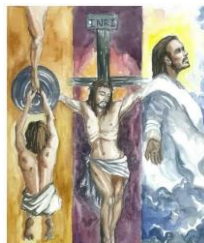

Stations of the Cross will take place at

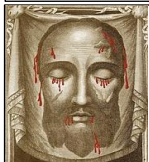
7pm each Friday in Lent. Adoration of the Blessed sacrament finish at 7pm on these days.
